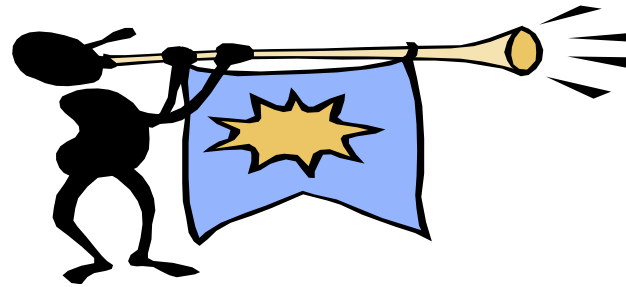

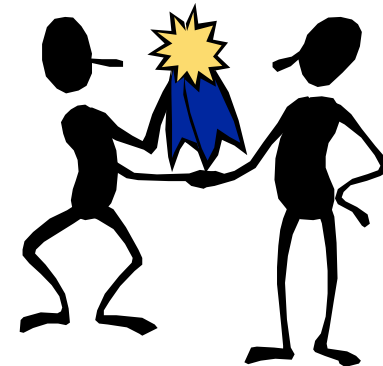
My Purpose

Training background

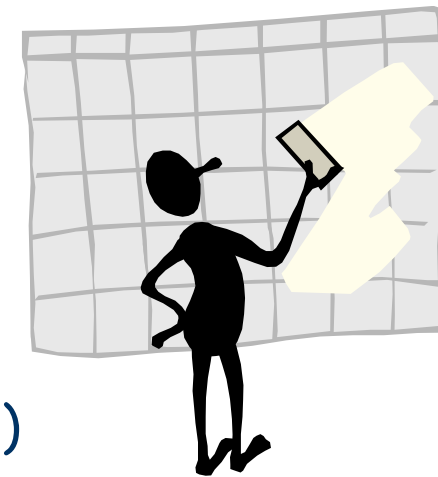
- Involved in the start up of Institute of Logistics training service; this pioneered competency based professional qualifications in the supply chain sector
